LC-FAODs (long-chain fatty acid oxidation disorders) are rare, life-threatening, autosomal recessive genetic disorders characterized by acute crises of energy production and chronic energy deficiency. They can lead to severe depletion of glucose in the body and serious complications, which can lead to hospitalizations or early death. Expanded newborn screening is widening phenotypic understanding of these disorders, as well improving our knowledge of disease incidence.
